CONDITIONS OF ENTRY AND RULES OF SHOW

1. **Horse and Pony Entries:** Online and Postal Entries close Tuesday 23rd July 2019. Fees must accompany postal entry forms.
2. Entries can also be made on the field but will incur an extra charge of €4.
3. Postal entries to Kilmacanogue Horse Show, Oaklodge, Ballyross, Enniskerry, Co. Wicklow. Enquiries – office@kilmacanoguehorseshow.com or 087 332 4928
4. **Sheep Entries** or enquiries: Assumpta Maguire 01 2952823
5. **Dog Show, Photography, entries can only be made on the Field.**
6. Exhibitors alone are responsible for entries. The Committee reserve the right to refuse any entry unconditionally.
7. **Where there are 3 entries in a class 1st place prize only will be given, for 3-5 entries in a class 1st and 2nd prize will be given. For 6 or more entries 1st, 2nd and 3rd place prize will be given. Rosettes will be awarded down to 6th place.**
8. The Committee reserves the right to abandon or postpone the show or cancel/alter any class.
9. The onus is on the exhibitor/competitor to be at his/her class before judging commences.
10. Jumping competitors must be ready to jump when called by steward.
11. While every reasonable precaution will be taken, the Organising Committee of the Show OR the landowners cannot accept responsibility for any loss or accident to exhibits or exhibitor while in the Show Grounds.
12. Horses must be provided with sufficient halters and caretakers must be in attendance at all times during the day.
13. **Exhibitors must comply with all Department of Agriculture rules and regulations. Equine Premises numbers and equine passport numbers must be included on Entry Form.**
14. To comply with Health and Safety regulations, competitors, exhibitors, trade stands and visitors must adhere to any safety instructions issued by stewards or officials and all obey all safety signage.
15. Exhibitors accept that the judge's decision is final in all cases.
16. Perpetual Cups and Trophies must be returned in good condition to the secretary 1 month before the next Show Day.

ISA DISCIPLINE CODE

The Irish Shows Association expects and will insist upon appropriate behaviour from all exhibitors and others participating in any of the activities at our member shows and will not tolerate inappropriate behaviour.

Inappropriate behaviour shall include but not be limited to the following:

Profanity, Coarse or vulgar language or gestures towards judges or other show officials.
Harassment or bullying, including using words or actions that threaten, intimidate or undermine judges or other officials before, during or following member show activities.
Failure to follow rules and/or obey instructions. Abusing any animal.

Disciplinary Procedures:

Complaints of misconduct against an exhibitor or other participant at a member show shall be investigated and adjudicated upon by a subcommittee appointed by the Irish shows association. The said subcommittee shall consist of three members of the board of the Irish Shows Association and shall be known as the disciplinary Committee. The disciplinary Committee shall seek to ensure the existence of consistent, effective, fair and transparent complaint procedures and shall act in accordance with natural and constitutional justice. IMPORTANT NOTICE to Animal Owners involved in Showing Animals.

INTENDING EXHIBITORS ARE ADVISED TO ENSURE THAT THEIR PUBLIC LIABILITY POLICY COVERS THE EXHIBITION OF BLOODSTOCK/LIVESTOCK AT PUBLIC SHOWS.

The Irish Shows Association would advise all Animal owners who have their Animals Insured to have the Insurance cover extended to cover them while showing animals at Shows, we understand cost is very little or nothing at all. If you are one of the few who don't have cover we would advise that you consider putting it in place for this purpose. The reason for this advice is to protect yourself in the event of your animal lashing out and injuring someone or damaging someone's property.

SPECIFIC REQUIREMENTS HORSE AND OTHER EQUINES

PREMISES REGISTRATION

As from 1st May, 2012, any premises (which includes shows, fairs and markets) where horses or other equines are gathered must be registered with the Department. Owners/persons in charge of such gatherings are required to submit a completed application form for registration and to keep records of movements on/off their premises. Records must be retained for at least 3 years as they may be required by the Department for the purposes of tracing disease. Records required are: The name and address of the owner/person in charge of the premises from which the equine came and Premises registration number from which the equine came and Passport number/UEL number of the animal. RACEHORSE TO RIDING HORSE RETRAINING CLASS

Open to thoroughbred horses that have started under rules on either the track or point to point but must not have:

- Won more than 3 classes in either retraining or novice classes under Racehorse to Riding Horse Ireland rules
- Won an open class under Racehorse to Riding Horse Ireland rules
- Won or been placed in the first three places or a championship such as the Royal Dublin Horse show, Balmoral, Hickstead or the Royal Windsor Horse show.

Passport and racing details to be made available for inspection on the day of the show.

Snaffle bits only to be used. No spurs allowed. Martingales acceptable.

Open horses may enter but must adhere to retraining rules of snaffle bit (snaffle mouthpiece on curb bit is not acceptable) and no spurs and will not be eligible to be placed in the prize money.

The class will ride as a group in which horses will perform walk and trot only on both reins. Each competitor will perform an individual show displaying a walk, trot, and canter (on the correct lead) as well as a gallop before returning to a halt (to be maintained for 5 seconds).

Competitors must have attained their 15th birthday.
