1. **Entries:** Entries close Thursday 30th July 2020. Payment only accepted online. Photos and videos should be sent to comp@kilmacanoguehorseshow.com.
2. Exhibitors alone are responsible for entries. The Committee reserve the right to refuse any entry unconditionally.
3. A first prize will be awarded in all classes and an electronic commemorative certificate to all participants.
4. The Committee reserves the right to abandon or postpone the show or cancel/alter any class.
5. Exhibitors accept that the judge's decision is final in all cases.
6. Videos only accepted in mp4 format.
7. Photographs and videos for each class will be displayed on the Horse Show website www.kilmacanoguehorseshow.com. Enter NO in the image option field on the entry form, if you would prefer not to have your entry displayed. NOTE: All Winners photos/videos will be displayed, to which you give your consent by agreeing to the Conditions of Entry and Rules of the Show.

Entries will be judged on pictures or videos by an appropriate judge for each class

EQUINE CLASSES

Class 1 Fancy Dress for pony and rider

Judged on the originality, effort and overall effect. Submit 2 photos of rider and pony together or a short video.

Class 2 Performance Hunter – 60 - 70cm Fence

Submit a video of less than 30secs, demonstrating the perfect jump. Video must include an approach around a corner, jump and ride away. Jumps will be judged on rider's position and horse's way of going, before during and after jump.

Class 3 Performance Hunter – 80 -90cm Fence

Submit a video of less than 30secs, demonstrating the perfect jump. Video must include an approach around a corner, jump and ride away. Jumps will be judged on rider's position and horse's way of going, before during and after jump.

Class 4 Riding Class for 10 – 12 year olds

Judged on rider's position and pony's movement. Submit a video of less than 2 minutes demonstrating an individual show

- Walk away from the camera in a straight line
- Trot a large half circle before changing the diagonal across the centre.
- Repeat on the other rein to complete a figure of eight.
- (OPTIONAL - Canter as you start a new figure of eight – if you established the correct bend you should get the correct leg. Canter a large half circle and return to trot to cross the diagonal. Repeat on the other rein but do not change the diagonal this time.)
- Come smoothly back to trot and walk before halting in front of the camera.

Class 5 Riding Class for 13 -16 year olds

Judged on rider's position and pony's movement. Submit a video of less than 2 minutes demonstrating an individual show

- Walk away from the camera in a straight line
- Trot a large half circle before changing the diagonal across the centre.
- Repeat on the other rein to complete the figure eight.
- Canter as you start the new figure eight – if you established the correct bend you should get the correct leg. Canter a large half circle and return to trot to cross the diagonal. Repeat on the other rein but do not change the diagonal this time.
- Come smoothly back to trot and walk before halting in front of the camera.

Class 6 Style and Appearance

Judged on pony and riders turnout. Submit two photos or a short video.

Class 7 Best Pet

Submit a photo or short video of your pet and let us know what makes your pet, a winner in the Additional Info Field on entry form.

Class 8 Back Garden Dog Agility

Submit a video of less than 1 minute, showcasing your dog's agility over a home built course. Judged on accuracy, speed and adorability.

Class 9 Lockdown Living - Back to Basics

Submit max of two photos or short video showcasing your lockdown activities and give us all the details in the Additional Info field on entry form. Anything goes, baking, gardening, painting, getting back to nature or something completely different. **Country Life (Glanbia-Co-op) Vouchers for the Winner.**
